Angel Dust is a beautiful example of the Oyster 66, with stunning looks and excellent performance. She offers luxurious accommodation with a light and airy interior. On deck, the twin helm area is separate from the seating area allowing ample room within the cockpit for guests to enjoy meals al fresco, whilst admiring the scenery.

Below deck, the split-level saloon has panoramic views and the Oyster Deck Saloon design, helps a fresh sea breeze to pass through the yacht. The interior joinery is beautifully crafted in Teak and upholstered in a light sumptuous Alcantara.

The Master Cabin aft has a luxury double berth, abundant storage space and an en-suite head. Steps offer a private companionway to the aft deck via a sliding hatch.

Angel Dust has a bunk cabin starboard aft, with comfortable upper and lower bunks and a further double cabin, to the portside with an en-suite head.

Anton Mussche and Clémentine Sys

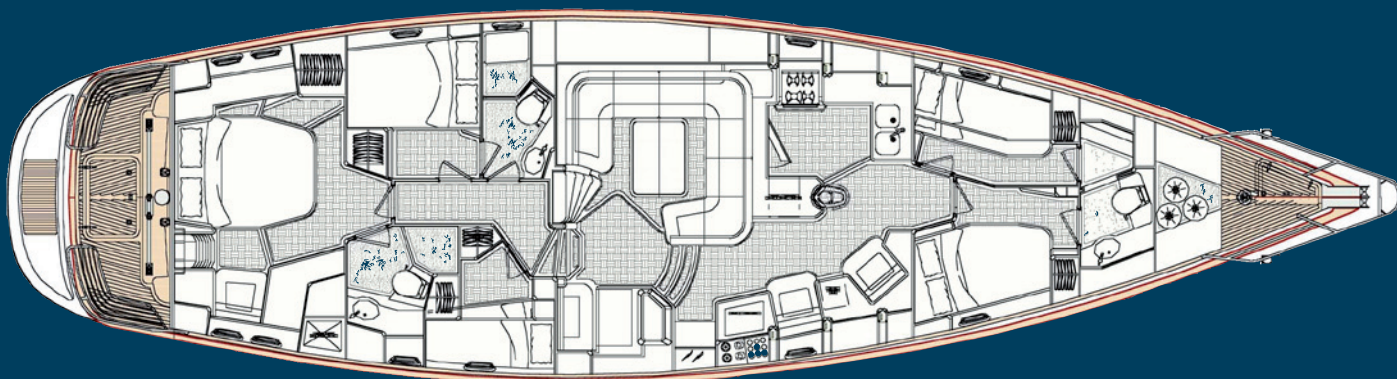
